## COVID 19

### The current situation for schools

On 26 March, the Premier, Mark McGowan, announced that whilst all public schools will remain open until the end of term, families are strongly encouraged to keep their children at home if they have the capacity to do so.

The Minister for Education, Sue Ellery, further announced the following:

Parents and carers who need their children to attend school to enable them to maintain employment, and those children in vulnerable families, such as children living with grandparents, can continue to attend school.

From 6 to 9 April 2020, arrangements will be in place to allow students to continue to attend school and be supervised. No student will be turned away

from school if they attend during this time.

These changes in the week of 6 April will provide the opportunity for teachers and other school staff to prepare for a different way of teaching and learning in Term 2.

On 26 March, the Prime Minister, Scott Morrison, stated that in Western Australia formal classes will end on Friday 3 April, with families encouraged to keep their children at home from Monday 30 March.

### The current situation for Camboon

At this stage, advice from the Department has been that schooling is likely to be done at home in Term 2, however, as you know, the situation is quickly evolving, and we will keep you informed of any changes, via Connect.

Parents have been provided with information and ideas for what to do with students who are at home, in the lead-up to the school holidays, including how to access the Department's website [learning at home](#).

Staff are currently, and will continue to work on planning for home schooling, in the event that this is required for next term. In the meantime, our suggestion is to not go too hard on the home schooling, and let your kids have a break.

### How can I protect myself and others against COVID-19?

1. Select a Child
2. Select a Date
3. Select Meals you would like to order for your child and add them to cart
4. Confirm the Order and click "PAY & PLACE ORDER"
