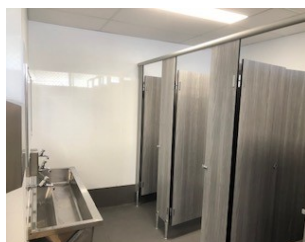
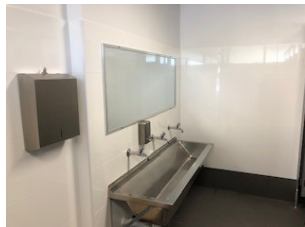

COVID 19 restrictions being eased

As you would be aware, the state government are easing some of the COVID 19 restrictions. In-line with this, from next Monday 8 June, parents will be able to enter school grounds. Please note that parents will still not be able to enter school buildings, and are asked to refrain from doing so. The teachers of Kindy to Year 2 students will no longer walk students to the gates at the end of the day. Parents of Kindy and Pre-primary students will need to collect their children from classes as they did last term. Parents of Year 1 to 6 students will need to make arrangements to meet their children at a designated point at the end of the day, as was the case prior to COVID 19. There will no longer be the staggered end to the day, and all students will finish school at 3pm. We thank all parents for their patience and adherence to the restrictions during this difficult time, and we will keep parents informed of future changes as they happen.

COVID 19 lessons

As educators we often look for learning opportunities, and COVID-19 has certainly presented us all with many learning opportunities. One that I have noticed and would like to continue to see, is *student independence*. When parents were not allowed on school site, at first some students and parents were a bit nervous. Now we see students full of enthusiasm and excitement about coming into school on their own, carrying their own bag, setting themselves up for their day, etc. I would like to see this continue and ask that parents support their child to continue this independence and feel free to still drop-off and pick-up outside the gates as we have been doing.

Have you ever found yourself ready to burst into tears in the most inopportune time? Needing to have a cry or feeling anxious when we are surrounded by others can feel so stressful and cause even more panic. Did you know counting backwards can help calm you down? I count backwards by 3's. This is more complicated for the brain but if your child is just learning, a simple count backwards from 10 would work. The brain needs to concentrate on counting backwards so it switches focus and this often works to stop the tears or panic.
