## Cyber Safety

As children start to navigate the online world and interact with others more independently, they are more likely to be exposed to risks such as bullying or accidentally coming across inappropriate content. Parental guidance is needed to help children be aware of the risks and understand how to behave responsibly when online. The eSafety Commissioner website has the following advice for parents of children aged 5 to 12;

- Keep the computer or device in an area of your home that can be supervised and check-in regularly with your child to see what they are viewing.
- Stay engaged with their online activity. Consider setting-up your own accounts with the sites they use most so you can see how they work and understand the risks.
- Explore the online world with them and play games together. An alternative is to do a creative project together.
- Think about your child's social media readiness. Most social media sites require users to be at least 13 years of age before they can register.
- Encourage respect and empathy. Teach your child to not share or post things that may upset others.
- Start building resilience. Teach your child what to do if anything worries or frightens them. This includes immediately telling you or another trusted adult of any concerns or uncomfortable material.
- Encourage them to learn about online safety.

## Student assessment requests from parents

From time to time parents may seek advice or therapy from an outside agency, and in many cases, these therapists and specialists liaise directly with classroom teachers in order to provide a wrap-around service for students. There are also times when these agencies request that teachers do a checklist or provide information that helps give a clearer 'picture' of the student. It is our preference that teachers have formal meetings with parents **prior** to checklist requests. We also request that when teachers are asked to do checklists for specialists, the return email address is provided so that the teacher can send it directly

back to the specialist. Parents are then asked to provide a copy of any reports or information from the specialist as a result of the completion of checklists. This helps to ensure that teaching staff are aware of interventions and needs of all students. If ongoing communication is required between teachers and specialists, parents will be asked to sign a consent form.

## PBS News

### GOTCHA tickets

Students have started earning GOTCHA tickets this week. There are new temporary collection boxes outside the library for students to post their GOTCHA tickets into. There is also a display of the cluster totals so students can keep track of how their cluster is going towards reaching their goal of 500 GOTCHA tickets.

### Conversation Cards

A conversation card provides an opportunity for students to have a discussion about their behaviour as well as providing a teaching opportunity for the desired behaviour expectations at Camboon. We are wanting to change the mindset that getting sent to the office leads to students getting into trouble or getting a detention. Sometimes all that is needed is a reminder of the expected behaviour, some help to decide on a better choice for next time, and a chance to 'reset' before successfully going back to class. These are now being used to record behaviour incidences instead of the old pink slips.




#### 3-6: Create a Book Cover:
