2020 Enrolments closing FRIDAY 26 JULY 2019

If you know of any families with children eligible for Kindy next year, (born between 01/07/15 and 30/06/16), who are interested in applying to enrol at Camboon PS for 2020, please let them know to apply now.

All applications for enrolment are due by Friday 26 July 2019. Please note that an *Application for Enrolment* can only be made at one public School.

Applicants will be advised in writing by late August of their success in obtaining a place for 2020. Successful applicants will then be required to complete full enrolment forms.

Please note that students already attending Kindergarten at Camboon Primary School this year are required to apply for Pre-primary 2020.

Application forms for these students have already been distributed. Current students from Pre-primary to Year 6 are automatically enrolled in each subsequent year and therefore it is not necessary to complete another application.
