I. R. O. **S**. E. – Self-Aware

Being self-aware is a skill that helps your child recognise and understand their thoughts, feelings and actions. This leads to understanding how others may see them and how their actions affect themselves and others around them. Self-aware children understand how their actions are perceived by others, know when to engage their strengths, when to pull back, and discover areas in which they need improvement.

Here are some ways that you can support your children to be self-aware:

- Be a positive role model.
- Help them recognise and accept their emotions.
- Empathise with your child.
- Develop good communication between you and your child
