Mobile phone policy

The State Government recently announced a new Student Mobile Phones in Public Schools policy to take effect from the start of Term 1, 2020. The policy requires all public schools to implement a ban on the use of mobile phones for all students from the time they arrive at school to the end of the school day. This extends to the use of smart watches. As we already have a phone use policy that meets these minimum requirements, there will be no changes for our school. Our existing policy will remain in effect. This requires *parents to inform the classroom teacher if their child will be bringing a phone to school. Phones brought to school are to be handed in to the class teacher at the beginning of each day to be locked away and returned to students at the end of the day. Smart watches must be placed in aeroplane mode at the beginning of the day. We accept no responsibility for any loss or damage of these items.*

Infectious Diseases
