Accessing the school

Parents are requested to NOT enter the school grounds without calling first (9276 5832), unless dropping students to school. If parents want to come to the school for any other reason, a call will need to be made first, and you are requested to then go straight to the administration building only. This is to help ensure staff and student safety.

It is highly likely that more things will be sent home for use next term, and further arrangements will be made once this has been fully planned.
