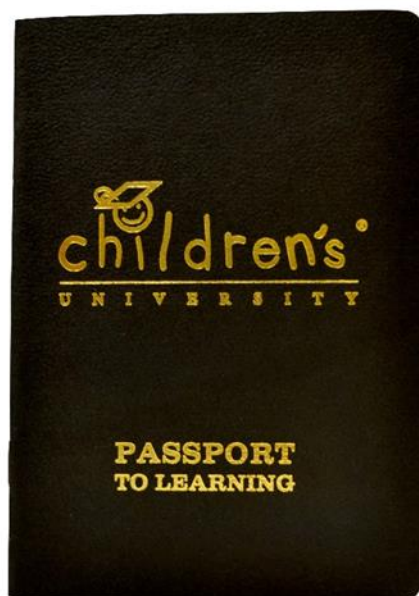

For each activity you do, you'll get a **stamp** in your *Passport* for the amount of time you spent learning. The things you learn about will always be able to be connected to something that you could study at a **university**, which is a place where you can keep learning after you finish school.

The more learning you do, the more hours and stamps you'll get. Once you have collected enough hours you and your family will be invited to a **graduation**, where you will be presented with your certificate at a special ceremony, all dressed up in a cap and gown, just like the older university students!
