CHILDREN'S BOOK WEEK 2021

This year Camboon Primary School will be celebrating Children's Book Week during the week beginning 9 August (Week 4, Term 3). The official Book Week is later in the year, but we have chosen to do it earlier. The theme of Book Week this year is "Old Worlds, New Worlds, Other Worlds". Students will have the opportunity to participate in a range of literacy related activities throughout the week, including our BIG items:

GUESS THE BOOK COMPETITION (Monday 9 to Friday 13 August)

Outside the library each morning there will be a hidden book with clues for students to guess the book. There will be a competition for K-2 and 3-6, with daily prizes.

BUILD YOUR OWN WORLD COMPETITION (Thursday 12 August)

Students can get creative and "create their own world". Students may create their own world in any way, this may include (but is not limited to) drawing, poster, diorama, painting, sculptures, Lego or writing. Prizes will be awarded to a winner from each class. These must be in by Thursday 12 August, 9.30am to be judged.
