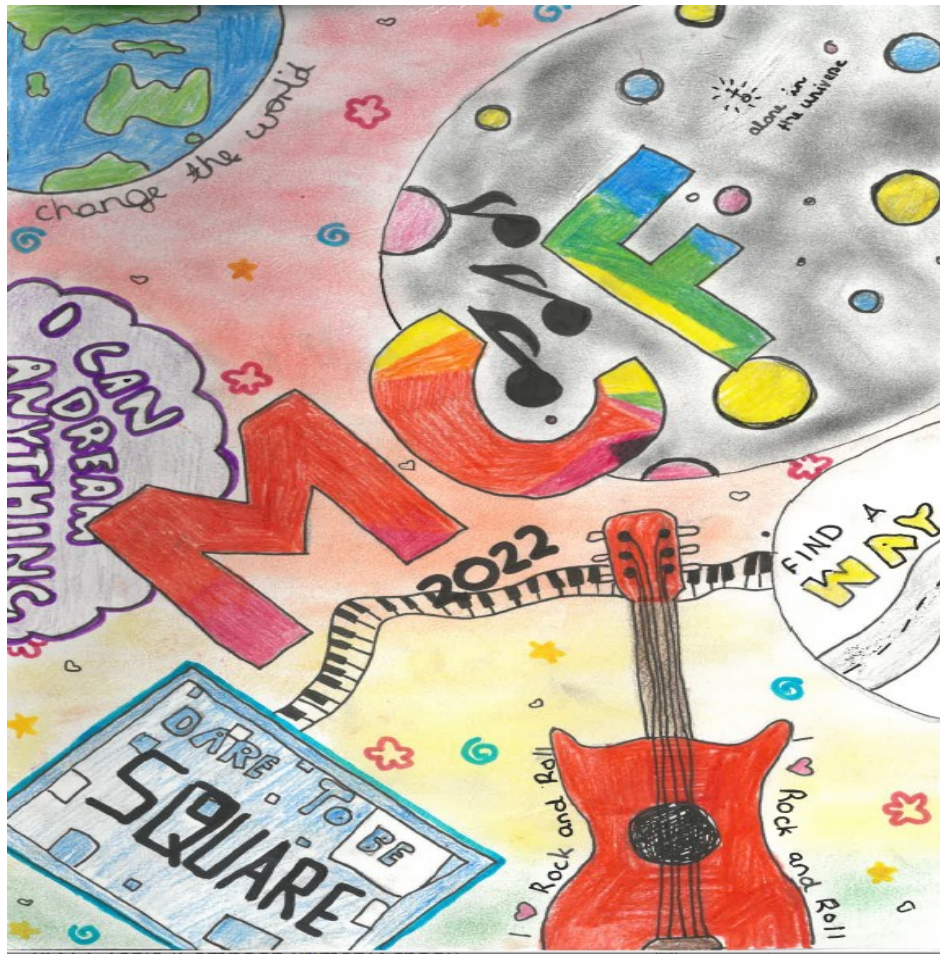

A gratitude jar is a fun way to create a visual reminder of all the things we are grateful for in our lives.

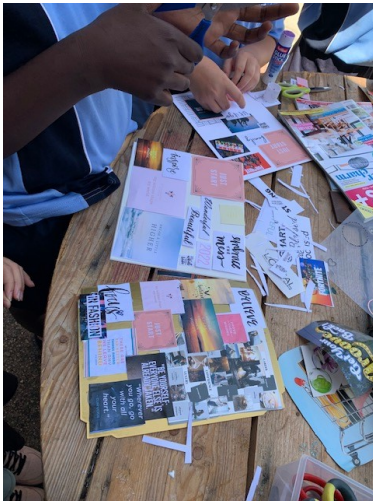


Breathing Sticks
