Before School

This is a friendly reminder to parents, regarding student drop off times before school. Parents are discouraged from sending their children to school prior to 8.30am for safety reasons, however, from 8.20am there is a Deputy Principal on duty in the undercover area. If students arrive between 8.20am and 8.35am they are asked to report to the DP, in the undercover area. At 8.35am a bell is rung for students to move to classrooms.

Copies of NAPLAN Results and School Reports

Parents who require past copies of NAPLAN results or school reports are asked to contact the office and allow 5 working days for the staff to process the request.

Parking

We request that parents <u>do not</u> use the staff or canteen car parks, including when dropping-off and collecting children. Your cooperation is necessary to ensure the safety of all students. During school hours, cars should park in the Wylde Road Reserve car park or on the streets around the school as sign-posted. City of Bayswater rangers occasionally do parking inspections and hand-out infringement notices, so please take note of parking signs. Please do not do uturns on Forder Road during peak times, as this puts others in danger, and please observe speed signs.

After School Tennis Term 3

Tennis lessons are being offered again in Term 3, commencing this Thursday 21 July. Students are collected by the tennis coach on Thursday afternoons from the undercover area at 3.15pm, and walk to the Morley/Noranda tennis courts where they are supervised until their tennis lesson starts at 3.45pm. Enrolments for 2023 Kindergarten are now open.

If you have, or if you know of any families with children eligible for Kindy next year, (born between 01/07/18 and 30/06/19), who are interested in applying to enrol at Camboon PS for 2023, please let them know to apply now. Application forms are available from the school office.

Please submit applications with the following:

- Birth Certificate
- Medicare Immunisation History Statement
- Proof of current address
- Proof of Australian Citizenship
- Family Court Orders (if applicable)

Medicare Immunisation History Statements can be obtained using your Medicare online account through myGov or the Express Plus Medicare mobile app. Alternatively, you can call the AIR on 1800 653 809 to request a copy.

These must be no older than 2 months.

Pre-primary 2023 (current Kindy)

2023 Pre-primary enrolments are now open.

Students already attending Kindergarten at Camboon Primary School this year <u>are</u> required to apply for Preprimary 2023. Application forms for these students have been sent home. Parents can return application forms to the school office or class teacher.

It was lovely to see so many students attend our regular Tuesday morning rehearsal this week. It is essential that


choir students attend each week so they can learn all 11 songs off by heart by Week 6 for our first rehearsal at Churchlands Senior High School.
