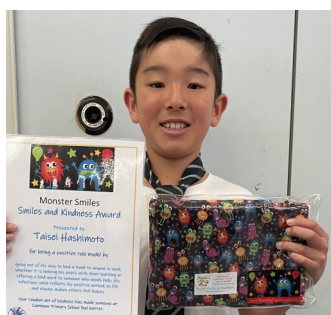
MONSTER SMILES

'We are Respectful' is one of our 3 key behaviours at Camboon Primary School. By demonstrating respectful behaviours, we are teaching students the lifelong skills needed to establish and maintain respectful relationships and treat people the way we would like to be treated. This helps keep our school a positive and safe place.

- We encourage our students to be respectful by:
- Looking at people when we are talking to them
- Saying 'please' and 'thank you'
- Greeting people when we see them
- Using whole body listening
- Waiting for our turn to talk
- Using kind and appropriate words and actions when we interact with others
- Valuing the personal space of others

These expectations can be further developed at home by encouraging your child to treat others in a kind and respectful way. By working together we can ensure a consistent message and promote positive relationships and an inclusive environment for everyone.
