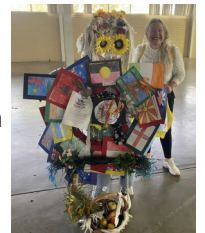
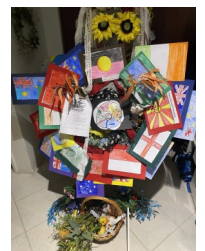
## Royal Show Scarecrow

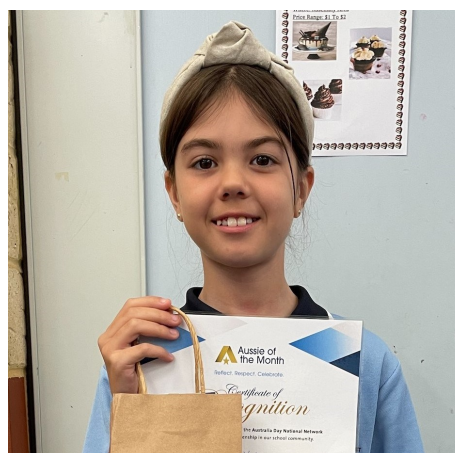


## Aussie of the Month

## 2024 INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC SCHOOL SERVICES

Year 7 is the final opportunity for new students to join the Instrumental Music School Services (IMSS) program. The IMSS program provides students with weekly lessons (free); an instrument available for hire for the first year of tuition on **selected instruments** (including routine maintenance); and performance opportunities throughout the year, either as a soloist or as part of an ensemble. Beginner places in the IMSS program are limited and expressing interest upon enrolment will not guarantee a position.

There are a number of factors pertaining to selection into the IMSS Program. Students need to be deemed suitable by current teachers; deemed suitable by the IMSS teachers if short-listed; not already learning the same instrument selected privately; achieve excellence in the music aptitude (MAI) test and have a high level of student support.

**Beginner Students** are offered tuition in flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, trombone, drums and percussion, bass guitar, guitar and vocals (not all offered instruments may run in 2024).

Some instruments can be hired for the first year of tuition through IMSS for \$110 (which includes routine maintenance).

It is an expectation that IMSS music students will practice daily as well as attend all rehearsals and performances.

IMSS lessons are conducted within the student timetable, meaning that IMSS students may miss part of their regular class lesson to attend their IMSS music lesson. Students are responsible for catching up on any work they missed while at their IMSS lesson.

**Continuing Students:** Year 7 students who were enrolled in the IMSS program in primary school will continue to receive lessons on their instrument at Hampton SHS.
