2024 SCHOOL VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS & CHARGES

1. School Voluntary Contribution

The School Education Act 1999 and the School Education Regulations (2000) allow schools to request financial contributions from parents/caregivers for students enrolled in Government schools. Contributions in this proposal are defined as voluntary contributions and are approved by the School Board. The School Contributions are separate from P & C fundraising activities.

The school receives a grant each year from the Department of Education, which provides most of the material and resources necessary for students to access educational programs. The voluntary contributions will assist the school to enhance programs by providing additional resources and materials.

The School Board, in discussing school contributions has endeavoured to take into consideration the level of contribution needed to provide necessary additional student resources, materials and activities that will enhance our educational programs without causing undue hardship to parents/guardians.

The School Board has decided that the school contributions for 2024 will stay the same at **\$60.00 per child** for all children in Kindergarten, Pre-primary and Years 1 to 6.

All contributions will be directed towards student learning through classroom and year level allocations and funding for extra materials used in educational programs and activities in which students are involved. The extent, of which, will be dependent on the classroom teachers learning program and will vary throughout the year. It will involve such things as Science, History, Technology consumables, classroom Art and cooking activities and subsidising special activities such as assembly items, Christmas, Mothers/Fathers Day etc.

The contribution is included in the Personal Items List order form and can be paid to Campion Education who will pass the payment onto the school.

If you **have not** included the contribution with the Personal Items List, we would appreciate your payment at the beginning of the 2024 school year as follows:

- Send to school in an envelope marked 'School Contribution'. A receipt is available by request.
- Paid at the school office during school hours (Cash or Cheque or EFTPOS).
 (EFTPOS on card presentation at front office only.)
- Paid by Direct Deposit

2. Personal Items

3. School Charges

The School Contribution does not cover extra activities that may be offered through the year. These activities are considered School Charges, are linked to the education program and are approved by the Principal. An example is: a class studying animals and wildlife may be offered an excursion to the Perth Zoo to view the animals in their habitats. These charges are an estimate of the maximum amount you may be asked to pay if child takes part in the activities. Parents/guardians will receive written notification of the activity and the permission forms for their child to attend.
