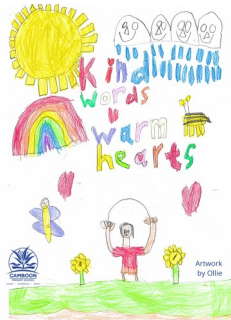

2027 ENROLMENTS

Please note the following Department of Education policy on Enrolments.

You need to apply to enrol your child if they are:

- Starting Kindergarten
- Starting Pre-primary (& enrolling for their first year of compulsory schooling)
- Starting Year 7
- Changing schools

Enrolment documents have been sent home this week to our current kindy students for 2027 Pre-primary enrolment.

Year 6 parents are reminded to enrol for high school, please note the DOE ask that all enrolments are submitted by Friday 24 July 2026 for 2027 Enrolments.

If you know families wishing to enrol Kindy and/or Pre-primary students, please encourage them to enrol at Camboon PS.



KINDY ENROLMENTS 2027

Kindergarten enrolments are now open for 2027. If your child will be 4 years old by 30 June 2027, enrol them in Kindergarten now.

Applications close 25 July 2026.

WITH YOUR APPLICATION PLEASE PROVIDE:

1. Birth Certificate or extract or other identity documents
2. Copies of Family Court or any other court orders (if applicable)
3. Proof of address
4. Medicare Immunisation Record (no older than 2 months)
5. Information relating to health or medical condition, disability or additional needs (if applicable)
6. If your child is not a permanent resident of Australia, you must provide evidence of current visa subclass and previous visa subclass (if applicable, such as if current visa is a bridging visa)

Please include your group preference with your application. Please note this is a preference only and there is no guarantee of group placement:

Kindy A - Mon, Thurs (alternate Wed)
Kindy B - Tues, Fri (alternate Wed)
